Expectations for the upcoming days

BBC reports: Israel has called up thousands of reserve troops and told civilians to quit southern Lebanon immediately, amid threats of a large-scale incursion. Israeli troops are already fighting Hezbollah inside Lebanon and have been heavily shelling the border area. The move has widened speculation that Israel is preparing for a large ground offensive. Israeli Defence Minister Amir Peretz has warned that Israel is prepared to launch a full-scale ground operation if necessary. The call-up came as Israel dropped leaflets on southern Lebanon warning residents to immediately evacuate an area approximately 32km (20 miles) wide.

We are currently waiting until all foreigners and Lebanese with a second passport evacuate and leave the country. At this point it is already noxious enough that "All-Americans" went first, followed by single-citizenship Americans, and followed up third by dual-citizenship Americans. The British likewise are separating families, and forcing decisions of who stays and who leaves when they are not abandoning people the piers. So as we wait, we see the evacuation ships by the shores of Beirut. The UN evacuated all its staffs and their families except for a few of their main representatives in Lebanon. It becomes so ironic when one thinks about it... evacuation takes place while the rest of the people with no second passport or those who took the decision to stay for the sake of the country know that the worst of the attacks are coming after the evacuation ships are no more in sight at sea.

A protest statement was signed by over 100 Iraqi civil society organizations in addition to several of the UN agencies in Iraq against the Israeli attack on Lebanon.
